CenGas – Mining corporation
Cid – Citizen identification device, also called c-chip, implanted with original genetic information
Comtech – Computer, technology control, and network operations
Con-Fed – European-Indian conclave comprised of the old EU, India, Singapore, and Thailand; launched three colony ships
Confederation – Worlds settled by Méridiens
Crats – Derogatory term for corporate management, corporate rats
Densing Array – Located on Naiad's rim
Everett Wormhole – Originates near Gelus system and leads to Axis Crossing
House Brixton – Méridien House responsible for the early creation of SADEs
Jargats – Race previously dominated by the Sisterhood
Justice Hall – Location of the Naiad Council
LH-6 – Processor in Escher's computer
LH-7 – Advanced controller processor found in sentinels, automated sentry bots
Limnad – Capital city of Naiad
Loops or Looping – Entering one end of a wormhole and passing through to the other end
Mechs – Agents who wear heavy modifications/augmentations
MN-18 – Series of processor
Mods – Augmentations/modifications to the body
Naiad Council – Home planet's ruling body, five members elected democratically
North American Confederation—Comprised of North America, Japan, and Israel, launched two colony ships
Pure Pour – Mining corporation on Kilmer
Raw Metals – Mining corporation known as Raw-Mets on Geneva
Regolith Recovery – Mining corporation known as Reg-Rec on Transit One
Russian-Chinese Concord – Launched no colony ships
Sentinels – Autonomous security bots
Ser – Méridien honorific for males and females
Sargut – President of Talusian system
Sisterhood – Name given to the collection of sisters
Tacnock – Jatouche alien who fought with the Pyreans
Talusians – Society of the Toralians and Sisterhood

Toral – Talusian world in a faraway area of space called the federacy
Vibro-blade – Monomolecular edged and energy-driven knife
X-Ore – Mining conglomerate, also called X-O

Planets, Stars, Systems, and Wormholes

Axis Crossing – Intersection of four known wormholes
Beta One – Mining planet one loop outward from Axis Crossing, X-Ore owned
Beta Two – Mining planet two loops outward from Axis Crossing, X-Ore owned
Calabas Wormhole – Located near the Gelus system
Delhart – Mining planet one loop outward from Axis Crossing, CenGas
Filium – Star location of Geneva, also referred to as Axis Crossing
Gelus – New system name for KL-1372
Geneva – Mining world owned by Raw Metals
Kilmer – Mining world
KL-1372 – Target star of colony ship *Destiny*
Mérïdien – Original home of the SADEs
Monart – Star location of Beta Two
Naiad – Name of colony planet in Gelus system
Satchel Wormhole – Unexplored wormhole that SADEs came through
Stabler – Star location of Beta One

Alexander – Cremsylon, Z, and Miranda's ship
Axis-ship – Ship designed to protect humans passing through wormholes
Destiny – Earth's fourth colony ship, the second Con-Fed launch
Dominance – Militarists' ship
Merrie – Knut Kielpinski's shuttle
Quadrant – Style of ship designed by Z and Miranda, the *Alexander*
Traveler – Sade/sister shuttle
Trident – Omnian tri-hulled warship
